## **SELFIE ART - IDENTITY:**

To complete this option, you need:

- something to take your picture with
- white paper one for printer and one for selfie-art
- *a printer (printing can be done in black and white / draft to save ink)*
- coloured felts or pencil crayons

**STEP ONE:** Planning: Brainstorm ideas and words that show your identity for each of the following areas:



Strengths and Interests – What do I like? What am I really good at? (At least 3)	
Values – What do we think is important? What do we think is right and wrong? Examples: Honesty, Kindness, Generosity, Good Manners, Loyalty, Determination, Creativity, Teamwork, Curiosity, Leadership, Patience, Trust, Acceptance, Cooperation (3 or more – choose the "most important' to you)	Personality – What are you like? How would someone describe you? (At least 3)
Where am I from? Culture / Language / Ethnicity / Religion (At least 2)	Gender Identity (1) – How do you identify? Examples: Cisgender Male, Cisgender Female, Transgender Male, Transgender Female, Non-binary

## **STEP TWO: CREATING THE ART**

1. Take a selfie or ask someone to take a picture of your face/head/neck. Print your whole-page selfie using black and white ink and the draft setting. Ask for help with this, if needed. You may want to put the picture on a blank document and make it fill most of the page before printing.

2. Choose the words from your planning that reflect your identity. Your teacher will be looking for:

- 3 (or more) strengths / interests
- 3 (or more) values
- 3 (or more) personality words
- 2 (or more) "Where I am From"
- 1 Gender Identity

- 3. Outline your selfie in black marker.
- 4. Trace the marker outline in pencil on a blank sheet of paper.

5. Fill your selfie outline with your traits with your neatest printing/writing –in various lettering, letter sizes, and colours. You need to fill up your selfie-outline like the example below. You can choose more words or repeat some words, if needed.

6. Erase your pencil lines.
